1. When will registration begin?

Online registration will begin on April 8, 2019 for ALL families.

2. My child already attends Vassiliadis, do I still need to register?

Yes, state law requires each student to register each new school year without exception.

3. If I do not register, will my child be placed with a teacher?

No, your child does not show up on our master register until you register online. To ensure that your child receives a class placement, please register as soon as possible.

4. Can I request a teacher for my child?

Although we do not accept specific requests, we do like to receive your input and offer a Teacher Qualities & Traits form that you are welcome to fill out, which helps to ensure that your child receives the best placement possible.

5. What if my new home is zoned for Vassiliadis, but will not be ready for move in August of 2019?

Not a problem, just call us at 702-799-1420 and we will take care of it.

6. How do I know if I filled out the media release portion of the online registration correctly?

It is very important that parents fill out this portion of your online registration correctly, as if you do not, your child may not be pictured in items like the yearbook, Vassiliadis website, Vassiliadis newsletters, and/or be able to access school computers.
