

# Online Registration Release Explanations

During Online Registration, parents will be asked to complete the following:

- 1) Restrict Release of Directory Information
- 2) Media and Public Release
- 3) Computer Network Access



In these sections, parents will be asked to give or not give permission within the three areas detailed below. Often these agreements can be unclear as to what you are granting and or restricting with your permission. We want to ensure you understand the choices so that you do not inadvertently restrict your child from the various publications or events. Please see below for detailed explanations.

## 1) Restrict Release of Directory Information

### 1. RESTRICT RELEASE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION

The term "Directory Information" means one or more of the following: student name, date and place of birth, address, school attended, years of attendance, grade level, photographs (only when used in **printed** school publications as defined in Clark County School District [CCSD] Regulation 5125.1), participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, and degrees and awards received. The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) allows CCSD to release Directory Information without the consent of the parent/guardian. However, a parent/guardian has the right to opt out of that disclosure.

You are required to select "Yes" or "No" to the following 3 subsections:

- (a)  Yes, withhold Directory Information from the Military (11th and 12th grade students only).  
 No, do not withhold Directory Information from the Military (11th and 12th grade students only).
- (b)  Yes, withhold Directory Information from all outside sources.  
 No, do not withhold Directory Information from all outside sources.
- (c)  Yes, withhold Directory Information from all CCSD school publications, such as the **ANNUAL YEARBOOK**, playbills, honor roll or other recognition lists, graduation programs, printed newsletters, and sports activity programs/sheets.  
 No, do not withhold Directory Information from all CCSD school publications, such as the **ANNUAL YEARBOOK**, playbills, honor roll or other recognition lists, graduation programs, printed newsletters, and sports activity programs/sheets.

**PLEASE note that if you select the "Yes, withhold Directory Information..." under subsection (c), your child **WILL NOT** be included in: The YEARBOOK, Newsletters, Printed graduation, Honor roll programs, Classroom Publications etc.**

## 2) Media and Public Release

### 2. CONSENT FOR CCSD AND MEDIA ORGANIZATIONS TO TAKE/USE PHOTOS, VIDEO, OR AUDIO OF STUDENTS AND OTHER STUDENT INFORMATION FOR USE IN NEWS MEDIA, SOCIAL MEDIA, AND OTHER PROMOTIONAL PURPOSES (BEYOND DIRECTORY INFORMATION)

During the school year, CCSD promotes the achievements and activities of students and school district programs.

CCSD requests parent/guardian permission to allow CCSD (including its schools) and media organizations to take/use photos, video, or audio of your child. This content – as well as other student information, such as a student's digital photo, description of school activities, or other school achievements that are already included in the student's education record – can be shared through news stories, social media, school newsletters, school websites, and other public presentations for informational/promotional purposes.

CCSD and the media organizations will comply with applicable CCSD policies and procedures regarding audio and video recording on school property.

I  give  do not give consent to CCSD and news outlets to take/use photos, video, or audio of my child for information/promotion purposes in print, broadcast, online platforms, or other public presentations.

**If you select "do not give", your child **WILL NOT** be included in: -- Any Non CCSD or Vassiliadis social media --News related stories during Reading Week, Vassiliadis Race, Winter Musical, filmed Assemblies/Awards or other celebrations etc.\***

### 3) Computer Network Access

#### 3. COMPUTER NETWORK ACCESS

I  **give**  **do not give** access permission for my student. Upon enrollment, each student will receive access to CCSD's technology resources to utilize, create, communicate, and exchange information according to the Acceptable Use Policy of CCSD. Student work, artwork, or projects will be labeled with the student's first name, grade level, and school only. The parent/guardian can opt out of this access at any time. If a parent/guardian requests to opt out of access to technology resources provided by CCSD, the student will be given alternative educational opportunities.

**If you select "do not give", your child WILL NOT be permitted to use computers during: STEAM Special, Technology Special, Standardized Testing, Writing, Researching, etc.**
