- School Performance Plan
 - > 3 Big Ideas: Response to Instruction (RTI), Professional Learning Community (PLC), Positive Behavior Support
 - ➤ Goal 1: Multi-Tiered System of Support
 - Support mental health & social emotional learning of students
 - Grades 3-5 students took Panorama survey
 - ◆ Flagged students who might need social-emotional support
 - Question: Will parents be notified? Yes, if additional support is needed
 - Create a streamlined process for RTI and behavior support
 - Provide professional development to teachers
 - Goal 2: Increase Proficiency in Reading & Math
- Strategic Budget Presentation
 - > 2021-2022 budget \$6,450,874.11
 - > Approximately 1,100 students enrolled
 - Change in At Risk & ELL Funding (now categorized in budget)
 - > School needs are in Special Education & Counseling
- Proposed Budget Changes
 - Adding new counselor from attrition fund
 - > ELL funding (has to directly benefit ELL students)
 - **\$73,197.00**
 - Pay for 1 salary for class size reduction
 - Pay for extended day for 1 teacher
 - At Risk funding (has to directly benefit at risk students)
 - **\$23,830.00**
 - Pay for extended day for 1 teacher and 2 prep buy out for 2 teachers
 - Additional hours for office manager
 - Additional budget money
 - **\$294,205.38**
 - Extra duty pay for licensed staff
 - SEIF pay 2 hours per week extended day
