### GENERAL EDUCATION PRESCHOOL STUDENT INTEREST APPLICATION

Vassiliadis Elementary School is pleased to provide an opportunity for three and four year old children within our community to be general education preschool students for the 2023-2024 school year. The purpose of a general education peer is to provide students with disabilities or delays positive role models with age appropriate social behavior and language skills.

**In order for your child to qualify to be a general education peer, they must meet the specific requirements listed below:**

- Child must be 3/4 years old
- Child must display age appropriate language skills
- Child must be a positive role model
- Child must be toilet trained
- Child must be independent and be able to be away from home for extended periods of time
- Child must be easy to understand and interact well with adults and children

**A "MEET AND GREET" will be held on Friday, March 24, 2023. 3 year olds will come from 9:00 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. & 4 year old will come from 10:00 a.m. to 10:45 a.m.** The purpose of this Meet and Greet will be for our Early Childhood staff to observe and interact with your child. During this time, Mrs. Lutke, our Early Childhood teacher, will be observing social interactions, language, attention to task, and ability to follow directions. The Meet and Greet is essential to confirm that children qualify to be a general education peer, prior to the lottery process, thus helping to ensure the success and growth those students with disabilities and delays.

If you are interested in having your child be a general education peer in Mrs. Lutke's general education inclusion program, you must fill out and bring the application below, along with your child to Vassiliadis Elementary School on March 24, 2023 at the designated for the "Meet and Greet", where you child will be escorted to Mrs. Lutke's classroom (without parents) for this brief, fun, and interactive experience. Parents will check their child in with a staff member outside by the MP room and wait outside the school.

General education peer enrollment is limited to 12 students for Mrs. Lutke's morning session and 12 students for her afternoon session. If your child is selected, registration is required and updated immunization records must be provided. Parents will be required to transport to and from school and ensure that consistent attendance occurs with the exception of illness. You will need to be on time every day to drop off/pick up your child. If this becomes an issue or your child does not display age appropriate behavior or social skills in the classroom, your child may be removed from the program. This program will begin the first day of the 2023-2024 school year, which is August 7, 2023. The program will be half-day and held Monday through Thursday. The morning session will be from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and the afternoon session will be from 12:40 p.m. to 3:11 p.m.

**If you are interested in your child being a general education peer, please complete the application below and bring it to the meet and greet with your child on Friday, March 24, 2023.** If your child is selected for this program, we will contact you, using the information provided on the application by March 31, 2023. Unfortunately, we will not be able to notify you if your child is not selected for the program and they will be put on the waiting list.
