NEW BUSINESS

Grading Reform

- CCSD is currently rolling out its Grading Reform plan.
- > Vassiliadis already has many of the new grading procedures in effect such as:
 - 90%/10% Summative to Formative weighting
 - Allowing for retakes if score is under 70% on summative assessments
 - No retakes on formative assignments because they are used to drive instruction

Enrollment, Count Day, and Budget

- > We were projected for 995 students and currently sit at 1009 general education students.
- Count day is next Friday, September 10. All students currently enrolled at Vassiliadis on that day will count towards funding.
- > The September SOT meeting will be a working meeting for the upcoming budget.

Safety Updates

- > SafeKey has had upwards of 100 students each day, and they are over capacity.
 - For safety reasons, SafeKey has capped admission at 70 students, effective September 1, 2021.
 - Parents can pre register their children to ensure a spot.
 - After school clubs can also provide some relief for SafeKey.
- COVID Protocols
 - If any staff or student has been exposed and is at risk of infection, they will get a letter from CCSD.
 - This letter can be used as a "pass" to get a CCSD-approved rapid test at a participating high school.
 - For reference, at home COVID tests are not accepted as proof of a negative test, nor are negative rapid tests administered outside of CCSD.
 - Admin has sent out a flow chart to help staff decide if/when a student needs to go to the Sick Room.
 - School events with 250 1000 people will need to be held outside. Upcoming events such as Trunk or
 Treat might need to be restructured to fit current protocols.
